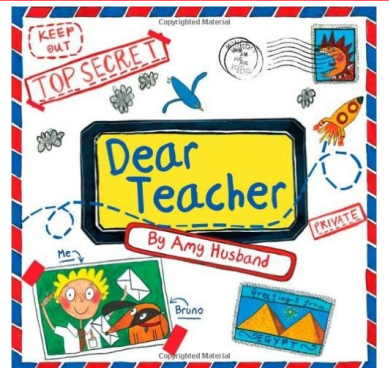
It was great to see some many of you at the Celebration Assembly this morning, I'm sure as I am many of your are still humming the tunes from the fabulous violin Performance!
