## Sensory Garden

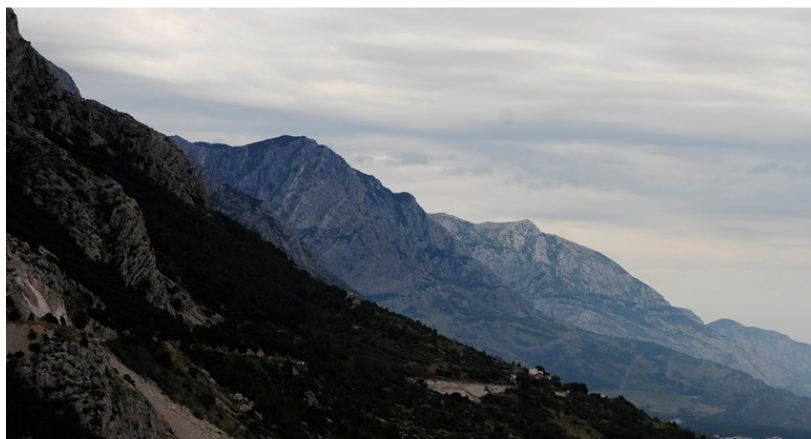
Year 2 and 3 are almost ready to plant up their garden plot. If anyone has any surplus stones, pebbles or bark we would happily accept it!
