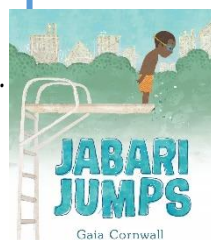
Thank you for returning your sponsorship money and forms. We made over £600 for the school, which will be invested into sports equipment for outdoor play.
