### School Store Cupboard

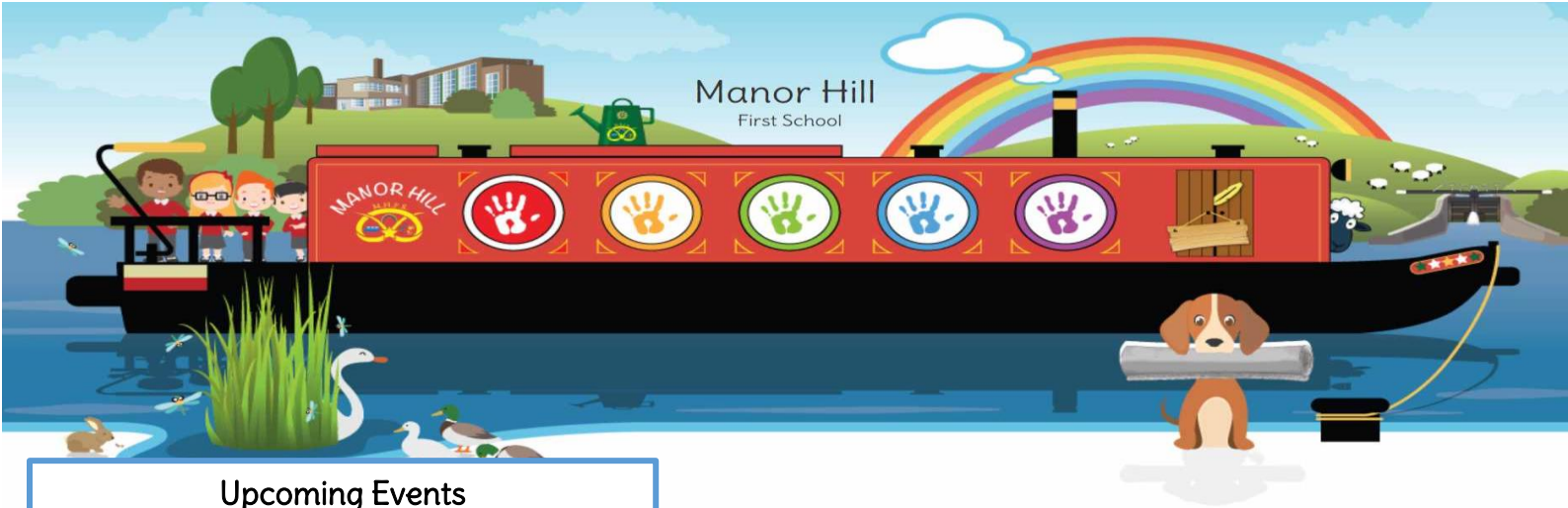

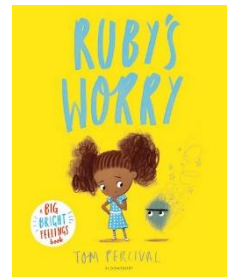
